

Announcing the Feast of Divine Mercy–April 8

The Shrine will be hosting a celebration of the Feast of Divine Mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 8, sponsored by the Diocesan Divine Mercy Apostolate. The 11 AM Mass will be held as usual.

Starting at 1 PM there will be confessions and the rosary. Starting at 3 PM will be the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, other prayers and concluding with Mass. For more information regarding the celebration, please call Jennifer English at 973-525-6692.

The Divine Mercy devotion (according to St. Faustina), offers a full pardon of the temporal punishment due to sin [like a plenary indulgence] to those who do the following on the Feast of Divine Mercy: 1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter. 2. Sincerely repent of our sins. 3. Place our complete trust in Jesus. 4. Make a good sacramental confession. This can be done during Lent or up to one week after the Feast of Mercy (as long as one is in the state of grace to receive communion on the Feast itself). 5. Receive holy communion on the day of the Feast. 6. Venerate the Image of the Divine Mercy. 7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

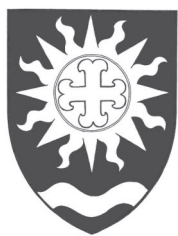
